A RESOLUTION CONVEYING STRONG SUPPORT TO THE ERECTION/CONSTRUCTION/INSTALLATION OF A MONUMENT OF THE LATE MAYOR EDUARDO “DUAY” M. CALIXTO IN THE CITY OF PASAY, RECOGNIZED AS ONE OF THE SIGNIFICANT PERSONALITIES BEING HIGHLY INSTRUMENTAL IN THE RECLAMATION OF THE AREA WHERE THE MALL OF ASIA COMPLEX NOW STANDS AND WHO IS KNOWN AS THE “FATHER OF DEMOCRACY” IN THE CITY OF PASAY, SUBJECT TO COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NHCP GUIDELINES ON MONUMENTS HONORING NATIONAL HEROES, ILLUSTRIOUS FILIPINOS AND OTHER PERSONAGES AND A DOCUMENTED CONSENT FROM THE PROPERTY OWNER, CONFIRMING AGREEMENT WITH THE PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, the Knights of Columbus, Capt. Manuel Colayco, Sr. Assembly CAN 3871 District XXIV, NCR-Southwest has endorsed Resolution No. 01, Series of 2024 urging the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Pasay to consider and approve the construction, putting up, and maintenance of a monument in honor of Hon. Eduardo M. Calixto, former OIC Mayor of the City of Pasay.

WHEREAS, this is to give recognition and honor to local heroes of the City regarded as the “*Magiging na Anak ng Pasay*” in order to remind its citizens and future generations, as well as the city’s visitors and tourists, of the outstanding contribution of individuals who have helped shape the rich history of the city.

WHEREAS, as supporting documents to the proposal are the Pasay Culture and Art Council’s cultural and heritage mapping program which recognizes Eduardo M. Calixto as a significant personality of Pasay and the Sangguniang Resolution No. 4624, Series of 2019 which recognizes the Cultural Property Inventory List.

WHEREAS, Sir EDUARDO “DUAY” CALIXTO had demonstrated exemplary leadership both as a private individual; and as a public servant in various capacities. He has served as a public servant for 26 years, holding positions such as *Teniente del Barrio* of San Jose, City Councilor, Vice Mayor and OIC Mayor of Pasay City. During his incumbency, he was instrumental in the development of the Reclamation Area where the SM MOA Complex is currently situated. During the Martial Law, he stood as one of the responsible opposition members who advocated for human rights and democracy in Pasay and the country as a whole, earning him the distinction of being called “*Ama ng Demokrasya ng Pasay*”.

WHEREAS, according to Ms. Evelyn Felizardo, Executive Assistant of the Tourism and Cultural Development Office, the National Commission for Culture and the Arts, the Philippine Registry of Cultural Property, and a 2019 City Resolution, all list former Mayor Eduardo M. Calixto as one of Pasay's significant personalities and proposed that the monument be constructed in a crowded location, particularly in the SM by the bay, which will serve as both a source of historical information and solidify historical facts about the reclaimed area.

WHEREAS, in a letter dated September 16, 2024, the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) recognized that the building of monuments is the purview of the local government. Nevertheless, it urged the Pasay City Government to review the proposal in consonance to the *NHCP Guidelines on Monuments Honoring National Heroes, Illustrrious Filipinos and Other Personages* and reminded that it is crucial to obtain documented consent from the property owner, confirming their agreement with the proposal.






